AVIATION I & II

Canyon High School has introduced an **Aviation Pathway**. In the fall of 2015 students will have Aviation I and II as elective options – classes that utilize various technology to introduce students to the Aviation industry with a focus on what it takes to **be a pilot!** At the core of the classes will be the required FAA knowledge content for achieving a Private Pilot's license.

- **Technology and Professionals:** The content will be enhanced with classroom simulators, computer applications, research, and industry professionals speaking to the class.
- **Exciting Potential Field Trips:** These would include airport and aircraft ground tours, flight school presentations, and industry experiences.
- **Licensed Pilot Instructor:** Mr. Smith is a licensed pilot and certified flight instructor (CFII) and will be teaching the classes.
