Extra-Curricular Suspension Policy



Suspendable Actions

Suspended or expelled students shall be excluded from all school-related extracurricular activities during the period of suspension or expulsion. (cf. 6245 - Extracurricular and Co-curricular Activities)

In addition, Canyon High School recognizes that our various extra-curricular programs represent our community. Actions that result in school suspension, regardless of the time, will also result in a week (7 days) suspension from extra-curricular events. These include artistic performances, athletic events, ASB activities and academic competitions. Upon completion of the school suspension, students may attend practices but will not be able to compete or perform until the 7 days extra-curricular suspension is completed. Participants will sign a code of conduct within their program agreeing to this rule. Subsequent offenses will result in progressive discipline and handled on an individual basis

Non-Suspendable Actions

Non-suspendable actions that may result in school discipline will not automatically incur the extra-curricular suspension. Academic integrity violations follow a documented discipline process which may affect extra-curricular participation but not automatically. Written consequences are outlined in the Canyon High School Planner.
