View Orange Unified School District's Board Policy on Supplementary Teaching Materials. Specifically, teachers shall carefully preview all supplementary instructional materials.

When a teacher desires to show a film that has not been approved by the District or county for use in the grade level taught, the teacher and principal or designee shall preview the film to determine whether in his/her professional judgement it is consistent with District criteria for the selection of instructional materials. All films must be appropriate for the curriculum and the students' ages. If the teacher has any questions about how established District criteria apply to the film, he/she shall confer with the principal or designee before showing the film.
