Congratulations on taking the first steps to becoming a National Honor Society member!

Being a member of NHS is an honor that you must work to uphold. To graduate as a recognizable member, all the following requirements must be met:

- An accumulation of 100 points obtained by April of your Senior year:
 1. Tutoring (Forty Points)
 2. Service Events (Sixty Points)
- All members must maintain an unweighted GPA of 3.5 in all variations. In addition, they cannot receive any N's or U's for their marks in citizenship and work habits.
- Members must follow the honor code at all times. Cheating will not be permitted and is grounds for immediate removal from NHS.

For further details, please examine the National Honor Society Constitution.

To become a member of the National Honor Society you must have at least a 3.5 unweighted G.P.A. in all variations and no N's or U's in citizenship and work habits. You must also write a paragraph to help us gain a better understanding of who you are, allowing us to decide your acceptance into the club.
