## PROGRESSIVE DISCIPLINE POLICY



Consequences resulting from infractions vary depending on the specifics of the discipline situations. However, Canyon High School stakeholders maintain a positive learning environment through the use of fair and consistent discipline policies.

Students who violate the discipline policy will face corrective action in the following sequential order:

### Progressive Discipline Steps

1. Teacher warning, Parent contact, Positive intervention strategy
2. Parent contact, Teacher-assigned consequence
3. Referral to Counselor or Administration
  - a. Detentions:
    - Zero Period truancy = 1 detention
    - Minor discipline infractions = 1 detention
    - 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Period truancy = 2 detentions
    - All Day truancy = 4 detentions
  - b. Saturday School
    - Repeat minor discipline infractions
    - More serious discipline infraction
    - No show to first SS, additional SS assigned.
  - c. Parent Meeting
    - After 2<sup>nd</sup> no show to SS
    - Major discipline infraction
    - Attendance or Behavior Contract
  - d. Suspension
  - e. Placement

### Cell phone/electronic device policy:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Offense:** 1 hour detention
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Offense:** 2 hour detention, parent notification
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Offense:** Referral to Counselor, Mandatory Saturday School, Parent/Guardian notification
- 4<sup>th</sup> Offense:** Behavior Contract, Parent/Guardian must pick up electronic device
